No. 153 It can be used only as a burying ground for such deceased persons as  
the Pastor of said Church shall decide to be entitled to a Christian burial, conformably  
to the Canons of the Catholic Church. Said Lot may be held by him and his heirs  
forever, or may be transferred to a member of the Church, with the approbation of the  
Trustees, subject to the foregoing conditions. Interments therein shall be subject to no  
further charges for the ground; but only to the usual funeral expenses.
