Baltimore Sun, Jan 29. 1858 - Inquest on the Body of James Maguire -

As was stated to be the intention, Coroner Stevens proceeded yesterday morning to the Cathedral Cemetery, accompanied by police officer Joseph Ellicott and Mr. George Perry, in search of the body of James Maguire for the purpose of holding an inquest. A reference to the record satisfied him that the body had not been interred there, and they next proceeded to St. Peter's Cemetery, with like success. At the first named place there was a large number of persons assembled when the coroner arrived, and they followed. They then went to St. Vincent's cemetery, and an examination of the record showed that the body was there deposited. It was disinterred under the direction of the coroner, and a jury of inquest summoned. (Note: a long description of the inquest followed, nothing is stated about the re-interment of the body)

McCALL, Patrick

"Fatal Fall" During Thursday night Charles Riley, stopping at the Franklin Inn, at the corner of Hillen and High streets, fell from the roof of the back building of that house, and, it is supposed, was instantly killed, his lifeless body having been found early yesterday morning. He had been in the regular Army of the United States for about five years, and was discharged

from the service a short time ago, when he came to this city. He was a native of Cavan County, Ireland, and met some friends from that country whom he knew in youth. Whether he sought the roof to escape the heat, or walked out on it while in a somnambulistic state, could not be ascertained. Coroner Brewer held an inquest on the body, and the jury rendered a verdict of death from a fall from the roof of the back building of the Franklin Inn. His skull was badly fractured on the back part, and his shoulders were much bruised. The body was removed to the dead-house at the central police station, and thence taken to St. Vincent's Cemetery.

MANNING, Malachi

Lawrence Barrett (April 4, 1838 – March 20, 1891), was an American stage actor who was partnered and acted with Edwin Booth.

He was born of Irish parents in Paterson, New Jersey. His family name **was Brannigan.**

Baltimore Sun - September 3 1885

Frank D'Antoni was shot dead yesterday morning, at half-past one o'clock in a saloon at 35 King street, near Eutaw Street, by Walter F. Welsh, proprietor of the saloon. Shortly before that time five Italians, D'Antoni among them entered the saloon, where a number of persons were assembled, and in a few minutes had created such a disturbance that Welsh was obliged to put them out by force into the street. In about ten minutes they returned by a side door from Grace's court and advance toward Welsh. D'Antoni was in front with a stiletto, and two of the men managed to get behind Welsh, who was backing away from the crowd. When he at last was cornered and D'Antoni still advanced with the stiletto in his right hand raised to strike. Welsh drew a five-shooter double action Smith & Weston revolver, of thirty-eight caliber and fired at D'Antoni who was a few feet away. The ball entered D'Antoni's right eye passing through the brain came out the back of the skull. He must have died instantly.

The body had been brought to the station house and a large number of Italians had collected there. After the verdict, which was self-defense, for Welsh the body was placed in a coffin and carried out into the yard, placed in a hearse and taken to St. Vincent Cemetery, where it was placed in a Vault, a burial certificate being obtained at the City Hall, on the way to the cemetery. D'Antonio, was thirty-eight years old and a single man. He lived with his mother at 38 Marion Street and kept a fruit stand at the corner of Howard and Lombard Streets. Later in the day Dominico D'Antoni cousin and Vincent Brocacao were arrested for assaulting Welsh.

A Touching Incident - An incident occurred at the City Hall yesterday which excited a great deal of sympathy, and at the same time aroused no little indignation in the health department. Mrs. Minnie C. Ashworth, a tidy little woman, appealed to Secretary A. R. Carter with tears in her eyes and voice choked with sobs, to bury her dead infant, a little boy 7 months of age, who had died of bronchial catarrh?, and whose wan little corpse she had in her arms wrapped against her bosom in a faded shawl. "How is it you bring the child's corpse to me?" the secretary inquired. "I have no place else to take it. I cannot leave it in the street. I am not permitted to let it stay where I have been living." To further inquiries she stated that she had carried the body in her arms through the crowded streets of the city from No. 214 South Durham street, between Aliceanna and Lancaster streets, where she has resided in the house of Theresa Rode, working in a pickling establishment for what money she could earn to pay for shelter, while her husband, who is a soldier in the United States army, was in Alabama. She said she was a native of Alabama and had another child older, whom she was obliged to leave with a friend while she went to the City Hall to have the child buried. She told Mr. Carter she was perfectly destitute and homeless; that she was not allowed to leave the corpse in the house on Durham street long enough to go to the City Hall to beg for its burial. A physician connected with the department certified that the cause of death was bronchial catarrh?, and it is believed that if the mother had been able to get medicines and attention for it the life of the child might have been spared. Secretary Carter, who was greatly touched by the incident, said it was the worst case he had encountered in all the years he had been in the health office. Mr. F. A. Kerschner, of the department, took the body in charge for burial, and Rev. E. Didler gave a permit for its interment in St. Vincent's Cemetery. The mother said she proposed putting her other child in an asylum, and it will probably go to St. Vincent's Orphanage. A sum of money was made up for her immediate wants by the attaches of the health department. The family at No. 214 South Durham street removed into country yesterday, and when the reporter went there the house was locked up.
